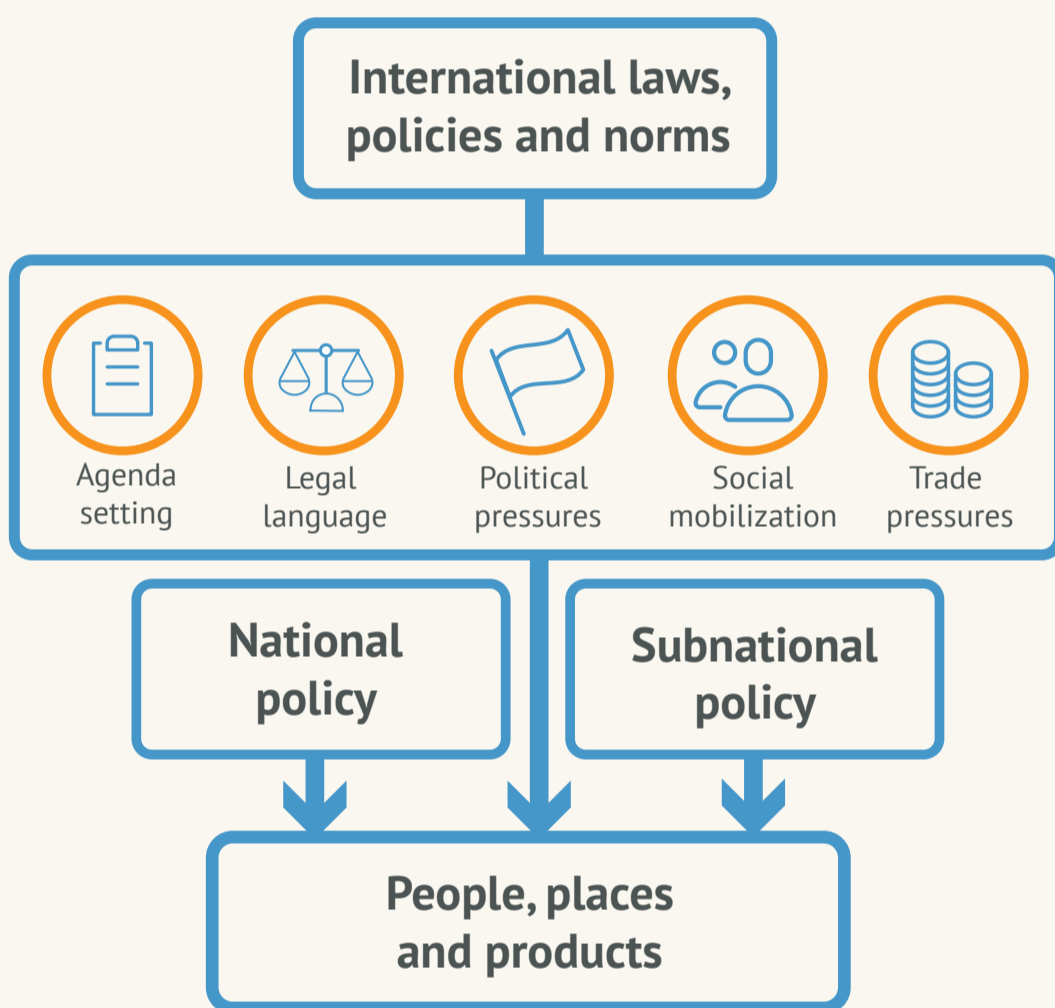
What is it?

Legal epidemiology uses rigorous methods to study the impacts of laws on population health and its determinants



Global legal epidemiology studies the global impacts of international laws, including pathways other than national laws
